PURPOSE OF PROPOSED RULES:

The University Hospitals Authority has conducted a substantial update to its acquisition and construction rules reflected in a new Chapter 11 which better reflect its updated practices and more closely reflect those acquisition and construction rules employed and adopted by other state entities. This Chapter 10 thus contains outdated content.

CLASS OF PERSONS AFFECTED/BENEFITTED:

Persons seeking to do business with the University Hospitals Authority.

PROBABLE ECONOMIC IMPACT:

1. On affected classes: The economic impact will only be that which persons seeking to do business with the University Hospitals Authority may expend, which is anticipated to be minimal only.
2. On political subdivisions: There will be little or no economic impact due to the proposed change.
3. Fees: The proposed rule change does not address agency fees.

PROBABLE COST TO AGENCY/OTHER AGENCY:

Minimal administrative only. No additional personnel or budget expenses are anticipated.
